- YES** It's about marginalizing and harassing Jewish students, as well as pro-Israel professors.
- YES** It's about creating a climate of intimidation on campus.
- YES** It's about modern-day antisemitism that masquerades as anti-Zionism and targets Jews on campus.

Israeli Apartheid Week is symptomatic of the growing radicalization of Canadian campuses.
