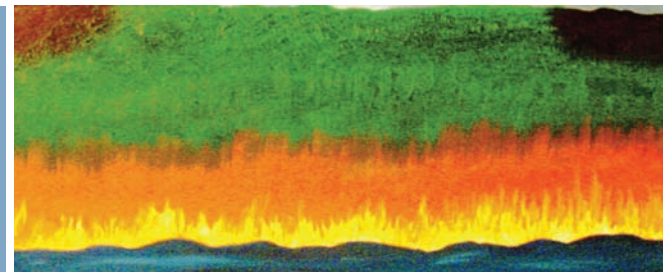
All proceeds will be donated to the capital fund for the new B'nai Brith Alzheimer's residence at 1 Kenton Place.
