

B'nai Brith Canada ANTI-HATE HOTLINE

- Synagogues were defaced with antisemitic graffiti.
- Homes and cars were vandalized with Nazi symbols.
- Visible Jews were harassed, threatened and physically assaulted.
- Jewish students on campus were called “murderers and criminals”.
- Graffiti on city streets proclaimed “Help save the world. Kill the Jews.”
- A Jewish applicant was chased away by a landlord who set his dogs on him.
- A Jewish elementary school was firebombed; other schools were threatened.
- Messages blaming Jews for the death of Jesus were spraypainted on Jewish homes.
